WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17



WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17



At 5:00 pm we'll come together at the celebrated **Hayes Street Grill**. Located just steps from the city's performing arts district, it's the perfect spot for a relaxed yet elegant dinner before a show. The menu highlights simply prepared fish and seasonal local produce, allowing high-quality ingredients to shine in meals that capture the spirit of California coastal dining.



After the performance, Annie Burridge warmly invites you to join her for a farewell drink at the Starlight Bar in the Beacon Grand Hotel, where we can toast to an unforgettable time together in San Francisco.
